**TRAVEL GUIDANCE**

**How to reach Venice from the Marco Polo airport**

**By bus**

- **LAND - BUS N° 5.** The buses leave from a stop conveniently located in front of the arrivals area. The ACTV buses are orange and the journey usually takes about 30 minutes. Ordinary tickets cost € 8,00 - ONE WAY and 15,00 € - from or to airport and return.

- **Shuttle ATVO** to Venezia, Piazzale Roma/ Bus Terminal. It's a direct connection from the airport to Venice that takes about 20 minutes; buses leave every half hour, from 8.50 (8.30 on Sundays and public holidays) to 23.40. Fares: one-way ticket is 8,00 €/ roundtrip ticket is 15,00 € (valid 7 days). The buses leave outside the arrivals area on the right. The ATVO buses are blue. **By taxi/water taxi**

Fare: about 35 € for land taxi and 100 € for water taxi

**How to reach Venice from the Treviso airport**

**By bus**

Direct shuttle ATVO to Venezia, **Piazzale Roma**/Bus Terminal Departs from a stop located in front of the arrivals area of the airport. Fares: one-way ticket is 12.00 €/ roundtrip ticket is 22.00 €

**By taxi**

Fare: about 60 €

**How to reach Venice by train**

Venice has rail connections with every major city in Italy and the rest of Europe. **The main train station (Venezia Santa Lucia)** is located next to the Grand Canal in the northwest corner of the city. Some trains stop at **Venezia- Mestre** on the mainland. To get from Venezia-Mestre to Santa Lucia, or vice versa (a 10-minute trip) you can take any train. However, please be aware that there is an extra charge for travelling on Intercity and Eurocity trains that should be paid prior to departure.

## Public Transportation within Venice

The public transportation in Venice is served by “vaporetto” boats. The company providing the service is called **ACTV** (website: <http://actv.avmspa.it/en/content/water-bus-service-timetable-0>). In the website you can find information about vaporetto lines and timetables.

An ACTV app is available and we do recommend to download it prior your arrival. On the APP you will be able to buy tickets and find information circa Venice transportation system.

### Tickets for public boats

Tickets from S. Zaccaria to San Servolo cost € 5.00 one way (ferry ticket, only 1 stop).

A one-way ticket valid for 75 minutes on the entire vaporetto network costs €7.50.

A good option is to buy a 24hr, 48hr or weekly ticket based on the length of your stay.

Take either Line n°4.1 or n°5.1 and get off at the San Zaccaria boat stop.  
At San Zaccaria, change to Line n°20, which leaves from the "San Zaccaria - Monumento" boat stop (see information above).

### **From Marco Polo airport**

There are several services that run from the airport to Venice:

#### **- Collective water taxi (direct) - Albatravel**

A shared water-taxi service from Venice Marco Polo Airport to specific stops in the city centre, including San Servolo.

Rate: € 68,00 up to 2 persons (per booking)

Each additional person: € 34,00

Night time supplement (before 7 am): 30% extra

To enjoy a further discount for us, VIU guests (, please use the following code when booking: "AlbatravelVIU".

Advance reservation is required: you must book and pay **at least 3 (working) days in advance**.

At shorter notice, reservations will not be guaranteed.

#### **- Collective water taxi (direct) night service - Bucintoro**

A shared water-taxi service from/to Venice Marco Polo Airport to/from specific stops in the city centre, including San Servolo. Reservation required.

Night trip 9.00pm/09.15am: € 38,00 p.p. minimum charge two guests

#### **- Water (direct) and land Taxis (via Piazzale Roma)**

You can take a private water taxi directly to your final destination (which is an expensive choice, from the airport to San Servolo it costs about €110.00). Alternatively you can take a land taxi to Piazzale Roma, and then follow directions from Piazzale Roma.

#### **- Alilaguna waterbus service (via city center)**

This company offers a service that goes from the airport to Murano, the Lido, the Arsenale with a final stop at San Marco.

Tickets cost €15.00 and can be purchased in the arrival hall of the airport, directly on board or online (€13.00). The service runs from 6am until midnight.

For timetables and further information visit Alilaguna.

Then follow directions from city center.

#### **- ATVO buses (via Piazzale Roma)**

These blue and yellow shuttle buses run from the airport to Piazzale Roma and they leave from in front of the entrance of the departure hall. Tickets cost €8.00 one way, €15 return. Automatic ticket machines can be found in the baggage hall, in the arrivals hall and outside the airport. The service runs from 4.20am to 1.20am and takes about 20 minutes to reach Venice. For timetables and further information visit ATVO.

Then follow directions from Piazzale Roma.
